# P 031 Matters arising from the minutes of the previous meeting

There had been no reply from TFL regarding a requested extension to the bus service. It was requested that the County Councillor pursue this.

## P 032 Flooding

The Atkins report had been published.

A multi-agency meeting was being arranged for the end of October which the Hill Resilience Officer would be attending.

RESOLVED: to include a link to the Atkins report on the Parish Council website.

#### P 033 Christmas celebrations

A meeting of the Working Group was to be arranged.

The Working Group recommended hiring new Christmas lights for the High Street and a quotation had been received.

RESOLVED: to approve a quotation for the 2018/19 Christmas Lights.

#### P 034 Commemoration of the end of WW1

The list of names of fallen servicemen was almost complete and locations for poppies had been arranged. It was planned to place the large poppies in shops and homes the week commending 15<sup>th</sup> October.

A request had been made for a silhouette at the Barracks.

As the Village Association were not enthusiastic about at commemorative tree at the Barracks it was suggested a tree be planted at the corner of Chaldon Road and Westway, in front of the public toilets. A Cedar of Lebanon was suggested.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- i. to approve a silhouette at the Barracks if one could be sourced at a cost of up to £150.
- ii. To request permission to plant a tree near the Westway toilets.
- iii. To ask the Tree Officer's advice as to an evergreen species and in particular a Cedar of Lebanon.
- iv. RECOMMEND: a budget of up to £1,500 for purchasing and planting a tree.

#### P 035 Litter / dog waste

Cllrs had met with TDC regarding their Litter Angel scheme and recommended that the PC promote the TDC scheme. TDC would provide the equipment and the Parish Council occasionally arrange group litter picks. This could be expanded to a Street Angel scheme once established. The dog waste dispenser trial had been a success and it was recommended that the scheme be expanded to other locations.

#### **RESOLVED:**

- ii) that the Clerk be delegated authority to site the dog bag dispensers in suitable locations. RECOMMEND: that a budget of up to £2,000 be allocated for 3 additional dog waste bag dispensers and bags.

RESOLVED: to write and thank TDC for their work so far and request that they provide sensory equipment.
