C 041 Declarations of interest arising from the agenda

C 042 Public forum

C 043 Douglas Brunton Centre (DBC)

The Chair informed the meeting that Tandridge District Council were considering leasing a large part of the DBC to St Catherine's Hospice and moving some existing services to alternative locations. A draft Parish Council response to this had been circulated and was discussed.
